

# ENERGY CONSERVATION OFFICER

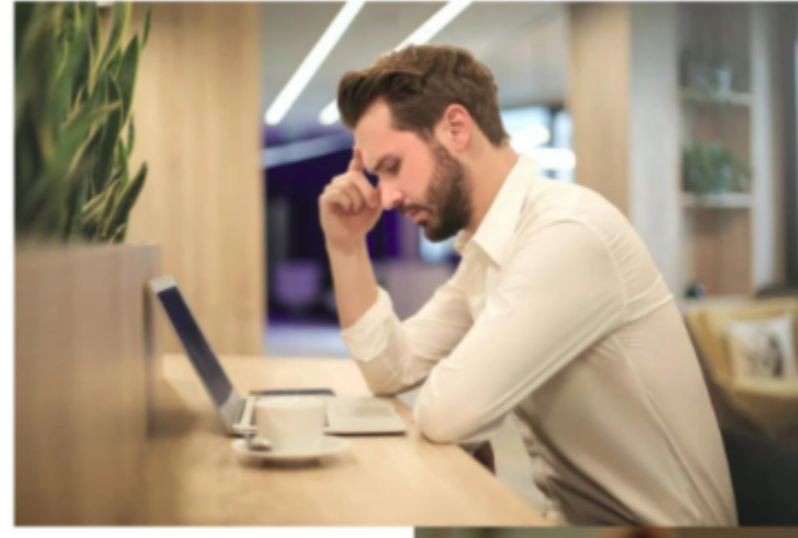
## DESCRIPTION

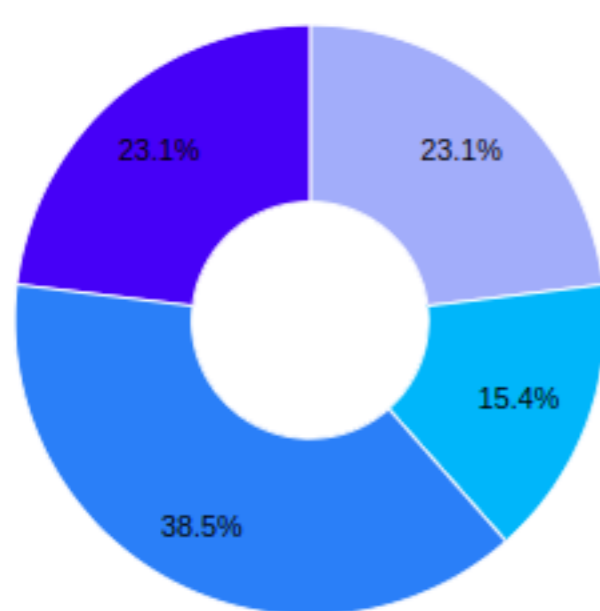
